



HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

March 11, 2022

Lakeside Cellars is committed to a healthy and safe work environment for employees, contractors, and members of the public.

We realize that our team and guests have different comfort levels during BC's Restart. We have outlined procedures in place during BC's Restart Plan effective **March 11, 2022**.

PROCEDURES

Reservations:

We have implemented a new reservation system through our website: <https://lakesidecellars.ca/reservation/availability/> and are able to accommodate eight seated groups of up to four guests, and one group up to ten guests indoors. To guarantee a seating, we are encouraging guests to book their tastings in advance. Walk-ins are welcome on a first-come, first-served basis.

Arrival:

An indoor check-in reception will allow us to seat guests with reservations or walk-in guests (dependent on availability). We ask guests to wait at our reception to be seated while maintaining appropriate physical distancing as indicated.

We are required to check Vaccination Passports at time of arrival. Any guests joining us for a tasting, regardless as to whether it is indoor or outdoor, seated or standing, will be required to show proof of full vaccination before being seated.

Guests:

Guests will have hand sanitizer provided upon being seated and upon request.

Traffic direction will be marked on the ground from reception and throughout the building, we ask guests follow provided signs/guidelines during their visit and be mindful of other guests' comfort level.

It is optional for guests to wear a mask.

Staff:

Staff members are not required to wear a mask; however, if requested by a guest, they will do so.

Staff will sanitize tables between groups, and washrooms as frequently as possible.

Plexiglass at the tasting bar and check-out stations are still being utilized at this time.
